



Career Encounters Permission to Participate

I give my permission for my student to participate in the Career Encounters class – a joint partnership between the Beaverton School District and Portland Community College. I understand and agree that:

- Career Encounters in Transportation Trades is an 11-week course taught at the PCC Rock Creek campus.
- Classes meet for approximately 2 hours, twice a week following the BSD A/B schedule.
- Classes meet from 1:30pm to 3:30pm. Once every 2 weeks students will stay an hour later to meet for their career guidance lecture. Class does not meet on Friday's.
- Students will receive hands-on experience in a variety of career areas.
- Regular attendance is required.
- All tuition, fees, equipment, and transportation will be paid for by the Beaverton School District.
- District buses will transport students to PCC.
- Students will be given Trimet tickets to facilitate their return home.
- My student will take **Early Release** during the parts of the semester when the Career Encounters course is not in session.
- My student will need to enroll online in PCC and receive a G-Number (student number).
- Usage of MyPCC, PCC email and D2L is required to check course schedule, submit assignments, and contact instructors.
- To earn both high school and college credit for this course, my student must successfully pass with at least a 70% accumulated grade.
- Students are expected to abide by all PCC and BSD expectations for appropriate conduct and academic standards.
- My student understands that attending all of the career guidance lectures and participate in online reflective writing exercises during the course is mandatory.
- A grading of *NO PASS* will be issued at the end of the term to any student who is absent for the Final.
